Trail passes will not be available at clubs, only through the AWSC office. If you sled is registered till 2016, a trail pass in 2015 is still required. The AWSC scholarships were awarded to Sarah Miley, \$1500 and Jade TenPas \$500; there were 60 applicants. 10 fatalities so far this year. March 23<sup>rd</sup> at State Fair Park is a sneak peak of Artic Cat and SkiDoo
